

AACA UNIFORM POLICY REVIEW

The goal of a uniform is to contribute to organization and assist in building a common community. We support a schoolwide uniform; however, we want to remain focused on the learning that takes place in and out of the classroom while student's comfort levels are taken into consideration. We have a basic uniform policy -- see below.

This new flexible uniform policy will be assessed on a trimester basis due to the current circumstances. All changes will be communicated to families from administration.

Regular School Uniform

- Blue or white collared AACA uniform shirt (shirts do not have to be tucked in)
- Khaki colored shorts (before Nov 1 or after April 1) and long khaki pants
- Black, brown or uniform plaid belt if wearing shorts or pants is optional
- Uniform plaid jumper for girls in K-3, plaid skirt for girls in 4-8
- During winter months, girls may wear solid black or navy blue leggings under skirts.
- Navy blue uniform cardigan, pullover or vest
- Monogrammed AACA fleece may be worn on regular uniform days
- AACA sweatshirts are allowed (including spirit wear)
- Other AACA sponsored tops may be worn in place of the collared uniform shirt. Examples include: Rocket Run shirt, Coach K's online spirit shop, etc.

Accessories

- One necklace worn under the shirt
- Bracelets worn on wrists or ankles are limited to two
- Girls' headbands are limited to solid uniform color (red, yellow, blue, black, white, gray) or uniform plaid.
- Sock should be solid colors (navy blue, white, black) or AACA navy or gold sports socks

Shoes

- Dress or gym shoes allowed with regular uniform
- Boots may be worn outside of school but not in classrooms

Gym Uniform

- AACA gym uniform t-shirt or dri-fit offered through spirit shop
- AACA gym uniform shorts in warm months, AACA navy sweatpants in cold months (Note: Girls may not wear leggings or "yoga" pants in place of sweatpants, but can be worn under shorts.)
- Gym shoes (any color)
- AACA sweatshirts allowed on gym days (including spirit wear)
